Setup

1. In Dorico **Setup Mode**, create a new layout with a condensed score of 2-3 staves and optional timecode staff.
2. Now in **Engrave Mode**, create a new **Page Template** and make sure it is assigned to all the pages

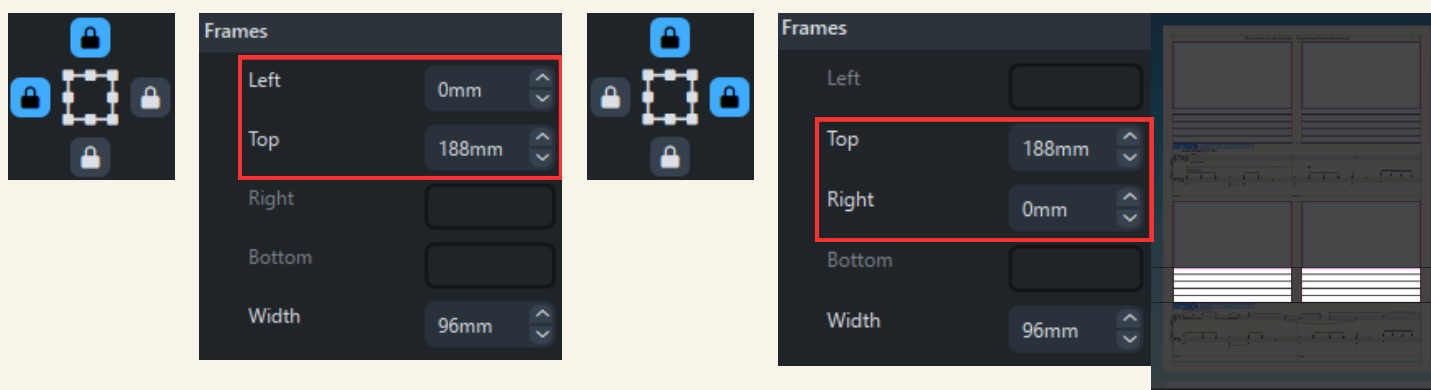
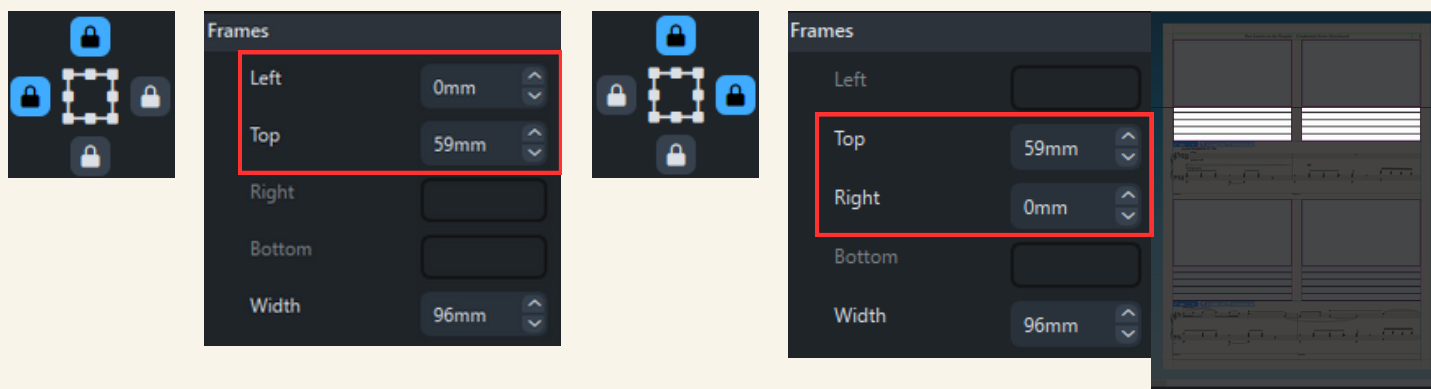
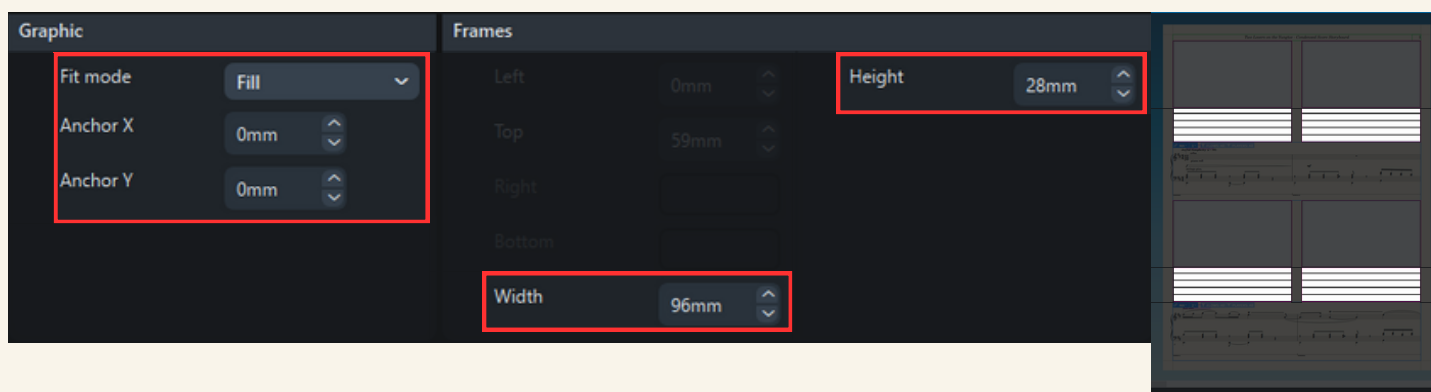
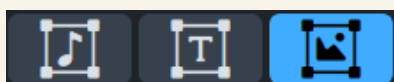
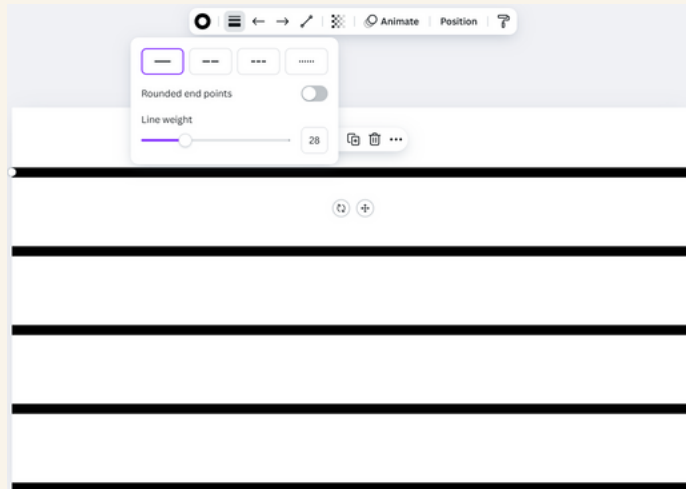
Blank Storyboard Boxes

1. In a photo app like **Cavna**, create a blank image (1920 x 1080)
2. Add a **Rectangle** element with transparent fill and black border
3. Export as PNG
4. Back in Dorico, create 4 **Graphics Frames** with the exported image and the settings below:



Blank Storyboard Notes

1. In a photo app like **Cavna**, create a blank image (1920 x 1080)
2. Add 4-5 **Line** elements with black fill and space evenly
3. Export as PNG
4. Back in Dorico, create 4 **Graphics Frames** with the exported image and the settings below:



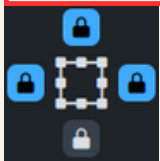

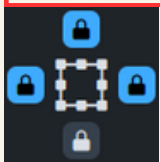
