






Setup

- 1. In Dorico **Setup Mode**, create a new layout with a condensed score of 2-3 staves and optional timecode staff.
- 2. Now in **Engrave Mode**, create a new **Page Template** and make sure it is assigned to all the pages




Header & Page Numbers

In our new Page Template, create 2 **Text Frames** using the settings below:




Blank Storyboard Boxes

- 3. Export as PNG
- 4. Back in Dorico, create 4 **Graphics Frames** with the exported image and the settings below:





























Blank Storyboard Notes


- 1. In a photo app like **Cavna**, create a blank image (1920 x 1080)

- 4. Back in Dorico, create 4 **Graphics Frames** with the exported image and the settings below:














